

John 6:5~ When, therefore, Jesus raised his eyes and observed, that a great crowd was coming to him, he said to Philip; Where shall we buy loaves for these to eat?

- 1· So when Jesus raised his eyes and saw that a great crowd was approaching him, he looked to Phillip and asked him; Where shall we buy loaves for all these to eat.

[Question] What concern did Jesus then express to Phillip, about the large crowd of people?

- 2· Now when he came forth, he saw a **great crowd**, and he felt pity for them, and he cured their sick ones. (**Matthew 14:14**)

[Question] How did Jesus feel when large crowds followed after him, and how did he treat their many sickly ones?

- 3· By now the hour had grown late, and his disciples came up to him and began to say; The place is isolated, and the hour is already late. (**Mark 6:35**)

[Question] What did his disciples then approach Jesus, and tell him?

- 4· Then the day started to decline. The twelve now came up and **said** to him; Dismiss the **crowd**, that they may go into the villages and countryside roundabout, and procure lodging and find provisions, because out here we are in a lonely place. (**Luke 9:12**)

[Question] What time of day was it then, and what suggestion did his apostles make, as to how to feed the crowds?

- 5· Send them away, that they may go off into the countryside and villages roundabout, and **buy** themselves something to **eat**. (**Mark 6:36**)

[Question] Where did they suggest, that the people go to, to get a meal, for the place was lonely?
