1. So when Jesus raised his eyes and saw that a great crowd was approaching him, he looked to Phillip and asked him; Where shall we buy loaves for all these to eat.

[Question] What concern did Jesus then express to Phillip, about the large crowd of people?

2. Now when he came forth, he saw a great crowd, and he felt pity for them, and he cured their sick ones. (Matthew 14:14)

[Question] How did Jesus feel when large crowds followed after him, and how did he treat their many sickly ones?

3. By now the hour had grown late, and his disciples came up to him and began to say; The place is isolated, and the hour is already late. (Mark 6:35)

[Question] What did his disciples then approach Jesus, and tell him?

4. Then the day started to decline. The twelve now came up and said to him; Dismiss the crowd, that they may go into the villages and countryside roundabout, and procure lodging and find provisions, because out here we are in a lonely place. (Luke 9:12)

[Question] What time of day was it then, and what suggestion did his apostles make, as to how to feed the crowds?

5. Send them away, that they may go off into the countryside and villages roundabout, and buy themselves something to eat. (Mark 6:36)

[Question] Where did they suggest, that the people go to, to get a meal, for the place was lonely?
