John 6:53~ Accordingly Jesus said to them; Most truly I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of man and drink his blood, you have no life in yourselves.

## **1** So Jesus continued with his point, that they must eat the flesh of the Son Of Man and drink his blood, to have everlasting life within themselves.

**[Question]** What though, did Jesus continue explaining, to show the incongruity of their thinking?

2. As they continued eating, Jesus took a loaf and, after saying a blessing, he broke it, and giving it to the disciples, he said; Take, eat. This means my body. (Matthew 26:26)

[Question] How did Jesus later explain to his disciples, how they must eat of his flesh, and was this literal of symbolic?

[Question] What did the shared loaf of bread at the Memorial mean or symbolize?

3 And, after giving thanks, he broke it and said; This means my body, which is in your behalf. Keep doing this in remembrance of me. (1 Corinthians 11:24)

[Question] What did Jesus state, that the shared loaf represents?

[Question] What did he then tell them, to keep on doing in remembrance of him?

For this means, my blood of the covenant, which is to be poured out in behalf of many, for forgiveness of sins. (Matthew 26:28)

[Question] What did the wine in the cup of blessing represent, and who was this blood poured out for?

5. He did likewise respecting the cup also, after he had the evening meal, saying; This cup means the New Covenant by virtue of my blood. Keep doing this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me. (1 Corinthians 11:25)

**[Question]** What did Jesus state, that the cup represented, and what did the wine within it symbolize?

[Question] What did the blood of Jesus institute or seal for them?

**[Question]** What was this observance to remind them of throughout time until his return?

6. For just as the Father has life in himself, so he has granted also to the Son to have life in himself. (John 5:26)

**[Question]** What does the Father have within himself, and what power has he given to the son also to have within himself?

7. To time indefinite I shall not forget your orders, because by them you have preserved me alive. (Psalms 119:93)

[Question] Why did the Psalmist not want to forget Yehowah God's orders?

8. And taking a cup, he offered thanks and gave it to them, and they all drank out of it. (Mark 14:23)

**[Question]** What did Jesus do, after offering the shared loaf to his disciples, and what were they all told to do?
