John 6:54~ He that feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood, has everlasting life, and I shall resurrect him at the last day.

1. So Jesus told those men, that he that feeds on his flesh and drinks of his blood, is the one that has everlasting life, and he would resurrect such ones on the last day. Now this terribly shocked many of those present, for they did not realize, that he was speaking symbolically, as was evidenced later, when he instituted the Memorial of his death.

[Question] What did Jesus state, that anyone eating his flesh and drinking his blood, had remaining within him?

[Question] How did the most of the people hearing this speech feel, when hearing Jesus state these things?

2. For this is the will of my Father, that everyone that beholds the Son and exercises faith in him, should have everlasting life, and I will resurrect him at the last day. (John 6:40)

[Question] What is the will of Yehowah God for Christ's disciples, and what is their hope?

3. In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, during the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised up incorruptible, and we shall be changed. (1 Corinthians 15:52)

[Question] When did Paul show, that this resurrection would take place, and then what would happen for faithful anointed Christians?

4. Because the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a commanding call, with an archangel's voice and with God's trumpet, and those who are dead in union with Christ, will rise first. (1 Thessalonians 4:16)

[Question] Who himself would descend from heaven, and what would he say to bring this resurrection about?

[Question] Who then, would be the first to rise in the resurrection?

5 Pay attention to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has appointed you, overseers, to shepherd the congregation of God, which he purchased with the blood of his own Son. (Acts of Apostles 20:28)
