^{John 6:56~} He that feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood, remains in union with me_r^1 and I in union with him.

Footnote: In union with me Or, in me Greek, en e·moi'

1 So he told them, that he who feeds on his flesh and drinks of his blood, is the one that remains in union with him. Also he would remain in union with all such ones.

[Question] Whom does Jesus Christ remain in union with?

2. In answer Jesus said to him; If anyone loves me, he will observe my word, and my Father will love him, and we shall come to him and make our abode with him. (John 14:23)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples, that they would have to do, to show that they truly loved him?

[Question] Who then, would come and make their abode with anointed Christians, if they did so?

3. Remain in union with me, and I in union with you. Just as the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it remains in the vine, in the same way neither can you, unless you remain in union with me. (John 15:4)

[Question] How did Jesus illustrate, how anointed Christians must remain in union with him, to grow spiritually and produce good fruitage?

4 Moreover, he who observes his commandments remains in union with him, and he in union with such one, and by this, we gain the knowledge, that he is remaining in union with us, owing to the spirit which he gave us. (1 John 3:24)

[Question] Who remains in union with God and Christ?

[Question] How do anointed Christians know, that they remain in union with Yehowah God?

5. So now, little children, remain in union with him, that when he is made manifest we may have freeness of speech, and not be shamed away from him, at his presence. (1 John 2:28)

[Question] What should anointed Christians try to keep, until the time of Christ's presence?

6. By this we gain the knowledge that we are remaining in union with him, and he in union with us, because he has imparted his spirit to us. (1 John 4:13)

[Question] How did anointed Christians know that Yehowah God remains in union with them?
