

John 6:58~ This is the bread that came down from heaven. It is not as when your forefathers ate, and yet died. He that feeds on this bread, will live forever.

1· So then Jesus showed, that he was thus the sustaining bread that had been given from heaven. Unlike the manna given to the Israelites there in the wilderness, those partaking of his body, the bread, and his spirit, the blood, would live forever.

[Question] Who then, was the true bread from heaven?

[Question] What hope then, did those partaking of his body and spirit, have before them?

2· I am the living bread that came down from heaven, if anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever, and, for a fact, the bread that I shall give is my flesh, in behalf of the life of the world. (**John 6:51**)

[Question] Who is the living bread, that comes down from heaven, and how long will anyone eating from this bread live for?

[Question] What bread did Jesus then give, in behalf of the life of the world?

3· When the sons of Israel got to see it, they began to say to one another; What is it? For they did not know what it was. Hence Moses said to them; It is the bread that Yehowah has given you for food. (**Exodus 16:15**)

[Question] What did the Israelites state, when first seeing the manna, hence its name manna?
