John 6:60~ Therefore many of his disciples, when they heard this, said; This speech is shocking! Who can listen to it?

1. Therefore many of his own disciples when they heard it, felt it was simply shocking, asking; Who can listen to this? Jesus had said these things, to weed out those who were not spiritually minded, from among the multitudes that wanted to follow him, many for the wrong reasons. It was a true test of their loyalty and faith and spirituallity.

[Question] What did many of Jesus' disciples then feel at hearing his words, though not understanding them?

[Question] Why had Jesus spoken thus, for who would this weed out from among his followers?

[Question] What then, did this serve as to these ones?

2. And happy is he that finds no cause for stumbling in me. (Matthew 11:6)

[Question] Whom did Jesus state would be happy, as one of his followers?

3. Owing to this many of his disciples went off to the things behind and would no longer walk with him. (John 6:66)

[Question] What then, did many who previously followed after Jesus, then do?
