John 6:63~ It is the spirit that is life-giving. The flesh is of no use at all. The sayings that I have spoken to you, are spirit, and are life.

1. Then Jesus made a powerful statement about the spirit of life within each one of us. This spirit is what is life-giving, for the flesh is of no benefit at all, for the flesh is simply a container for the spirit. Jesus then showed, that the sayings he had spoken to them were spirit, and were life, to all those accepting them.

[Question] What did Jesus then state, about the spirit within each one of us?

[Question] What then, is the flesh merely a container for?

[Question] What did Jesus show, that the sayings he spoke to them, were, in fact?

2. It is even so written: The first man Adam became a living soul. The last Adam became a life-giving spirit. (1 Corinthians 15:45)

[Question] What did the first man Adam become, and what kind of children could he make?

[Question] What did the last man Jesus Christ become, and what kind of children can he beget?

3. Who has indeed adequately qualified us to be ministers of a New Covenant, not of a written code, but of spirit, for the written code condemns to death, but the spirit makes alive. (2 Corinthians 3:6)

[Question] What adequately qualifies anointed Christians to be ministers of a New Covenant?

[Question] What was the result of the old Law Covenant for men?

[Question] What results from the New Covenant, for what does the spirit do for men?

4. Because he who is sowing with a view to his flesh, will reap corruption from his flesh, but he who is sowing with a view to the spirit, will reap everlasting life from the spirit. (Galatians 6:8)

[Question] What will anyone reap who sows toward the flesh?

[Question] What will the one sowing toward the spirit reap?

5. These things we also speak, not with words taught by human wisdom, but with those taught by the spirit, as we combine spiritual matters with spiritual words. (1 Corinthians 2:13)

[Question] What words did Paul use to instruct others with, and where did they come from?

6. So he humbled you, and let you go hungry, and fed you with the manna, which neither you had known nor your fathers had known, in order to make you know, that not by bread alone does man live, but by every expression of Yehowah's mouth, does man live. (Deuteronomy 8:3)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God humble the Israelites in the wilderness by making them eat manna forty years?

7. This is my comfort in my affliction, for your own saying has preserved me alive. (Psalms 119:50)

[Question] What did the Psalmist state, that had preserved him alive?

8. But in reply he said; It is written: Man must live, not on bread alone, but on every utterance coming forth through Yehowah's mouth. (Matthew 4:4)

[Question] What did Jesus state to Satan the Devil in defense of his position, that men must continue living by?

9. Keeping a tight grip on the word of life, that I may have cause for exultation in Christ's day, that I did not run in vain or work hard in vain. (Philippians 2:16)

[Question] What should men keep a tight grip upon, to what end?

10" Simon Peter answered him; Lord, whom shall we go away to? You have sayings of everlasting life. (John 6:68)

[Question] How did Peter answer Jesus, when asked if he wanted to leave, along with those other disciples, who were stumbled by what Jesus said?

11. Jesus said to him; I am the way and the truth and the life.

No one comes to the Father except through me. (John
14:6)

[Question] Who is Jesus in God's overall purpose, and can men ever come to Yehowah God except through him?

12. Yet he who searches the hearts knows what the meaning of the spirit is, because it is pleading in accord with God, for holy ones. (Romans 8:27)

[Question] Who uses the spirit to search the hearts of mankind, and what is the Holy Spirit pleading for, as it works within anointed Christian's hearts?

13. Also, accept the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the spirit, that is, God's word. (Ephesians 6:17)

[Question] What is the sword of the spirit, the cutting edge of God's instructions to mankind?

14. For you have been given a new birth, not by corruptible, but by incorruptible reproductive seed, through the word of the living and enduring God. (1 Peter 1:23)

[Question] What kind of birth have anointed Christians experienced through this anointing through the Holy Spirit, and through their study of God's Word the Bible?

15. In fact, for this purpose the Good News was declared also to the dead, that they might be judged as to the flesh, from the standpoint of men, but might live as to the spirit, from the standpoint of God. (1 Peter 4:6)

[Question] Why was the Good News of God preached to the dead also?
