**Owing to this, many of his disciples went off to the things behind, and would no longer walk with him.**

**1· So because of his statement here, which many found to be too shocking to continue to listen to, many who were once his disciples left him, and went back to the things behind, and would no longer follow him. Thus they stumbled over the stone of stumbling.**

**[Question]** What did many of Jesus' disciples then leave of following him over?

**[Question]** What stone then did they stumble over?

**2· Jesus said to him; No man that has put his hand to a plow and looks at the **things behind**, is well fitted for the kingdom of God. (**Luke 9:62**)**

**[Question]** What kind of man did Jesus tell them, that was well suited for the Kingdom of God, and who was not well suited for the Kingdom of God?

**3· And happy is he that finds no cause for stumbling in me. (**Matthew 11:6**)**

**[Question]** Who would be happy?

**4· Therefore **many** of his **disciples**, when they heard this, said; This speech is shocking! Who can listen to it? (**John 6:60**)**

**[Question]** How did many of Jesus' disciples feel upon hearing his words, about eating his flesh and drinking his blood?

**5· He was despised and was avoided by men, a man meant for pains, and for having acquaintance with sickness. And there was, as if the concealing of one's face from us. He was despised, and we held him as of no account. (**Isaiah 53:3**)**

**[Question]** How would Jesus be viewed and treated by his people, as prophesied by Isaiah?

**6· And happy is he who has not stumbled over me. (**Luke 7:23**)**

**[Question]** Who did Jesus state would be happy in him?
