

**John 6:68~ Simon Peter answered him; Lord, whom shall we go away to? You have sayings of everlasting life.**

**1· So Peter with loyalty and humility answered, whom could they go away to, for Jesus had sayings of everlasting life, and how very precious that is. The point of all this, was not to be quickly stumbled by words that one does not understand properly, but to remain in union with Christ, and to learn the full significance of matters in due time.**

**[Question]** How then, did Peter answer Jesus, for what kind of saying did Jesus Christ have?

**[Question]** What was the point then of this situation, and what is the proper way for us to deal with things, we do not understand?

**2· In answer Simon Peter said; You are the Christ, the Son of the living God. (Matthew 16:16)**

**[Question]** Who did Peter earlier state, that he knew Jesus to be?

**3· And he put the question to them; You, though, who do you say I am? In answer Peter said to him; You are the Christ. (Mark 8:29)**

**[Question]** Who did Peter state, that Jesus was, when asked his opinion?

**4· These are the ones that did not defile themselves with women, in fact, they are virgins. These are the ones that keep following the Lamb, no matter where he goes. These were bought from among mankind, as firstfruits to God and to the Lamb. (Revelation 14:4)**

**[Question]** What man alone, do anointed Christians follow on earth, and how does this make them virgins?

**[Question]** Where have anointed Christians been bought from, and where will their future life be?

**5· It is the spirit that is life-giving. The flesh is of no use at all. The sayings that I have spoken to you, are spirit, and are life. (John 6:63)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus state was life giving, and what is of no use at all in giving life?

**[Question]** What were the sayings Jesus spoke to his disciples?

- 6· This means **everlasting life**, their taking in knowledge of you, the only true God, and of the one whom you sent forth, Jesus Christ. (**John 17:3**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell his disciples was necessary for them to gain everlasting life?

- 7· Be on your way, and, having taken a stand in the temple, keep on speaking to the people, all the **sayings** about this **life**. (**Acts of Apostles 5:20**)

**[Question]** What were the apostleship told to do, when persecuted for preaching the Good News?

- 8· The heart of the wise one causes his mouth to show insight, and to his lips, it adds persuasiveness. (**Proverbs 16:23**)

**[Question]** What does a fine heart cause one's mouth to speak?

- 9· Because the **sayings** that you gave me, I **have** given to them, and they **have** received them, and **have** certainly come to know, that I came out as your representative, and they **have** believed, that you sent me forth. (**John 17:8**)

**[Question]** What sayings did Jesus speak to his disciples, and what did they come to believe about them?

- 10· Keeping a tight grip on the word of **life**, that I may **have** cause for exultation in Christ's day, that I did not run in vain, or work hard in vain. (**Philippians 2:16**)

**[Question]** What did Paul encourage anointed Christians to keep a tight grip upon, and why?

- 11· That which was from the beginning, which we **have** heard, which we **have** seen with our eyes, which we **have** viewed attentively, and our hands felt, concerning the word of **life**. (**1 John 1:1**)

**[Question]** How did John bear witness about Jesus, and what Jesus words to them meant?
