

John 6:69~ And we have believed and come to know, that you are the Holy One of God.

1· Peter then told Jesus, that they had believed and come to know, that Jesus was the holy one of God. So then, if they did not understand some matter perfectly, they would ask for clarification, or think, or pray about the matter, but they were not leaving. They were going to remain loyal to the manifestations of the Holy Spirit they had already seen evidenced in all of Jesus' works.

[Question] What did Peter say that his disciples had come to know, regarding Jesus?

[Question] What then, would be the proper way to treat any knowledge we do not understand completely?

[Question] What were Jesus' disciples then going to remain loyal and faithful to?

2· Saying; What have we to do with you, Jesus you Nazarene? Did you **come** to destroy us? I **know** exactly who you are, the **Holy One** of **God**. (**Mark 1:24**)

[Question] How did the demons many times identify Jesus?

3· Then he said to them; You, though, who do you say I am? Peter said in reply; The Christ of **God**. (**Luke 9:20**)

[Question] Who did Peter say that Jesus was, when asked by him to identify him?

4· Then those in the boat did obeisance to him, saying; You are really God's Son. (**Matthew 14:33**)

[Question] What did Jesus' disciples realize, after seeing him quiet a storm on the lake?

5· And he put the question to them; You, though, who do you say I am? In answer Peter said to him; You are the Christ. (**Mark 8:29**)

[Question] Who did Peter think Jesus was?

6· In answer the angel said to her; Holy spirit will **come** upon you, and power of the Most High will overshadow you. For that reason also, what is born, will be called holy, God's

Son. (Luke 1:35)

[Question] What power was Mary told by the angel that would overpower her, and what then would her child be?

- 7· **Others were saying; This is the Christ. But some were saying; The Christ is not actually coming out of Galilee, is he? (John 7:41)**

[Question] How did many in the crowds feel about Jesus, and his ministry, and what misinformation was common then?

- 8· **And to the angel of the congregation in Philadelphia write. These are the things he says, who is holy, who is true, who has the key of David, who opens so that no one will shut, and shuts so that no one opens. (Revelation 3:7)**

[Question] What key does the Revelation account show, that Jesus Christ has, and what does this key open the door for him to become?
