John 6:70~ Jesus answered them; I chose you twelve, did I not? Yet one of you is a slanderer. 1

Footnote: Or, is a devil Greek, di-a'bo-los' e-stin

1. At this time Jesus first made reference to the one that would later betray him, Judas, for he told his disciples, that even though he himself had selected them all, that one of their number was a slanderer. For he knew immediately, the one that would betray him.

[Question] What did Jesus then reveal to his disciples for the first time, though not specifically?

2. But when it became day, he called his disciples to him, and chose from among them twelve, whom he also named apostles. (Luke 6:13)

[Question] What did Jesus call his disciples together to do, and whom did he choose then, and what did he call them?

3. You did not choose me, but I chose you, and I appointed you to go on and keep bearing fruit, and that your fruit should remain, in order, that no matter what you ask the Father in my name, he might give it to you. (John 15:16)

[Question] Who choose Jesus' disciples, and what did he appoint them to keep doing?

[Question] If they continued in this fine fruit bearing work, then what confidence would they enjoy with Yehowah God?

4 But Satan entered into Judas, the one called Iscariot, who was numbered among the twelve. (Luke 22:3)

[Question] Who later entered into Judas Iscariot, though one of the twelve apostles Jesus choose?

5. I am not talking about all of you. I know the ones I have chosen. But it is in order, that the Scripture might be fulfilled: He that used to feed on my bread, has lifted up his heel against me. (John 13:18)

[Question] How did Jesus show, that one of his disciples would betray him later?

[Question] How did he also show, that this fulfilled scripture?

6. And you people will certainly say; The way of Yehowah is not adjusted right. Hear, please, O house of Israel. Is not my own way adjusted right? Are not the ways of you people not adjusted right? (Ezekiel 18:25)

[Question] How did Yehowah God show through the Son Of Man, that their ways were the ones needing to change?

7' While they were eating, he said; Truly I say to you, one of you will betray me. (Matthew 26:21)

[Question] What did Jesus then tell his disciples, while they were eating the Passover meal?

8. After saying these things, Jesus became troubled in spirit, and he bore witness and said; Most truly I say to you, one of you will betray me. (John 13:21)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples before the Memorial celebration?

9. To take the place of this ministry and apostleship, from which Judas deviated to go to his own place. (Acts of Apostles 1:25)

[Question] What did the other apostles later do, to fill the vacant position of Judas Iscariot?
