John 6:71~ He was, in fact, speaking of Judas the son of Simon Iscariot, for this one was going to betray him, although one of the twelve.

1. Jesus was of course speaking of Judas Iscariot who would later betray him, for he knew even early on who would betray him. Yet other than these subtle hints, the other eleven did not know what he meant.

[Question] Who was Jesus speaking of, but did his subtle hints give this away at the time?

2. Then one of the twelve, the one called Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests (Matthew 26:14)

[Question] Who later went to the chief priests to betray Jesus?

3. How long should the land keep withering away, and the very vegetation of all the field dry up? Because of the badness of those dwelling in it the beasts and the flying creatures have been swept away. For they have said; He does not see our future. (Jeremiah 12:4)

[Question] What did the men of Judah not think, that Yehowah God saw in their day, and so what was their mindset?

4 Because he had been numbered among us and he obtained a share in this ministry. (Acts of Apostles 1:17)

[Question] Who was Judas Iscariot numbered among, and what ministry did he earlier share in?
