[Question] Why did Jesus now concentrate his ministry in Galilee?

- 2· From there they departed and went their way through Galilee, but he did not want anyone to get to know it. (Mark 9:30)

[Question] What did Jesus then try to keep secret, and why?

- 3· On this account, indeed, the Jews began seeking all the more to kill him, because not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was also calling God his own Father, making himself equal to God. (John 5:18)

[Question] Why did the Jewish religious leaders want to kill Jesus?

- 4· For, look! They have lain in wait for my soul, strong ones make an attack upon me, for no revolt on my part, nor any sin on my part, O Yehowah. (Psalms 59:3)

[Question] How did the Psalmist prophetically show, how the Messiah would be treated?

- 5· Hence Jesus no longer walked about publicly among the Jews, but he departed from there to the country near the wilderness, into a city called Ephraim, and there he remained with the disciples. (John 11:54)

[Question] Who did Jesus then choose not to walk among, and where did he go to, and where was this city located?
