John 7:16~ Jesus, in turn, answered them and said; What I teach is not mine, but belongs to him that sent me.

1. Jesus answered these men with a response, that what he taught was not of his own originality, but came forth from the one who had sent him forth.

[Question] How did Jesus then answer such men, for where did his teachings come from?

2. For the one whom God sent forth, speaks the sayings of God, for he does not give the spirit by measure. (John 3:34)

[Question] What does the one God sent forth, speak to others?

3. Therefore Jesus said; When once you have lifted up the Son of man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing of my own initiative, but just as the Father taught me, I speak these things. (John 8:28)

[Question] What did Jesus state would happen to men who lifted him up in faith, respecting his role before mankind?

4 Because I have not spoken out of my own impulse, but the Father himself who sent me, has given me a commandment as to what to tell, and what to speak. (John 12:49)

[Question] What did Jesus never speak from, but whose commandment did he always speak and teach?

5. Do you not believe that I am in union with the Father, and the Father is in union with me? The things I say to you men, I do not speak of my own originality, but the Father who remains in union with me, is doing his works. (John 14:10)

[Question] What did Jesus tell them to believe about him, for what did he never speak out of?

6 A revelation by Jesus Christ, which God gave him, to show his slaves, the things that must shortly take place. And he sent forth his angel, and presented it in signs through him, to his slave John. (Revelation 1:1)

[Question] Who gave Jesus Christ the Revelation, to present it to his own disciples, and how was it then presented?

7. I have counsel and practical wisdom. I, understanding. I have mightiness. (Proverbs 8:14)

[Question] How do the Proverbs state, what the Messiah would possess?

8. And many peoples will certainly go and say; Come, you people, and let us go up to the mountain of Yehowah, to the house of the God of Jacob. He will instruct us about his ways, and we will walk in his paths. For out of Zion, Law will go forth, and the word of Yehowah, out of Jerusalem. (Isaiah 2:3)

[Question] What does Isaiah prophesy would happen to many peoples in the last days, and what would the people then seek from Yehowah God?

9. And as for me, this is my covenant with them, Yehowah has said. My spirit that is upon you, and my words that I have put in your mouth, they will not be removed from your mouth, or from the mouth of your offspring, or from the mouth of the offspring of your offspring, Yehowah has said, from now on even to time indefinite. (Isaiah 59:21)

[Question] What promise does Yehowah God make to his Messiah, and his future offspring?

10" This one came to him in the night and said to him; Rabbi, we know, that you as a teacher have come from God, for no one can perform these signs that you perform, unless God is with him. (John 3:2)

[Question] What did Nicodemus know and state to Jesus, and what proved this to him?

11. He that does not love me does not observe my words. The word that you are hearing, is not mine, but belongs to the Father who sent me. (John 14:24)

[Question] What does the one do, who does not love Jesus?

[Question] Whose word was this?
