

John 7:18~ He that speaks of his own originality is seeking his own glory, but he that seeks the glory of him that sent him, this one is true, and there is no unrighteousness in him.

1· Jesus then showed, that all men who do speak from their own originality, are only seeking glory for themselves. Jesus was different for he sought not personal glory, but to glorify the one that sent him, for this one, God, is true, and there is no unrighteousness within him.

[Question] What do men who speak out of their own originality, seek for themselves?

[Question] How was Jesus different in this, for what was he seeking?

2· I do not accept **glory from men. (John 5:41)**

[Question] What did Jesus not accept from other men?

3· But I am not **seeking glory for myself. There is One that is **seeking** and judging. (John 8:50)**

[Question] Who alone should be seeking glory for himself, and what also does this one deservedly do?

4· Really they have practiced no **unrighteousness. In his ways they have walked. (Psalms 119:3)**

[Question] How did the Psalmist show, how Jesus' disciples would act, in fulfillment of the Law Covenant?
