John 7:19~ Moses gave you the Law, did he not? But not one of you obeys the Law. Why are you seeking to kill me?

1[•] Jesus then testified against those Jews who had the Law Covenant and trusted in Moses, that not one of them fully obeyed the Law Covenant. So he asked them, why they were seeking to kill him.

[Question] What did Jesus then show these Jews, that they were not living up to, for what were they trying to do to him?

2. Then Moses came and related to the people all the words of Yehowah and all the judicial decisions, and all the people answered with one voice and said; All the words that Yehowah has spoken we are willing to do. (Exodus 24:3)

[Question] What had the Israelite nation as a whole, agreed to do forever in the sight of Yehowah God?

3. Moses laid as a command upon us, a Law, a possession of the congregation of Jacob. (Deuteronomy 33:4)

[Question] What Law then governed over all the Israelites, and especially those knowing the Law well?

4. This is he that came to be among the congregation in the wilderness, with the angel that spoke to him on Mount Sinai, and with our forefathers, and he received living sacred pronouncements to give you. (Acts of Apostles 7:38)

[Question] What kind of pronouncements did Moses receive from Yehowah God?

5. Why, then, the Law? It was added to make transgressions manifest, until the seed should arrive to whom the promise had been made. It was transmitted through angels by the hand of a mediator. (Galatians 3:19)

[Question] Why was the Law Covenant given to mankind first, and how was it transmitted to mankind?

6 But the Pharisees went out and took counsel against him, that they might destroy him. (Matthew 12:14)

[Question] What though, did the Pharisees go and seek to do to Jesus, out of jealousy?

7. At that the Pharisees went out and immediately began holding council with the party followers of Herod against him, in order to destroy him. (Mark 3:6)

[Question] Who did the Pharisees try to gain the support of, in their desire to kill Jesus?

8[•] Furthermore, he went teaching daily in the temple. But the chief priests and the scribes and the principal ones of the people were seeking to destroy him. (Luke 19:47)

[Question] Where did Jesus then teach daily, and what were the religious leaders of the Jews trying to do to him then?

9 Because the Law was given through Moses, the undeserved kindness and the truth came to be through Jesus Christ. (John 1:17)

[Question] What came through Moses, and contrastingly, what comes through Jesus Christ?

10. On this account, indeed, the Jews began seeking all the more to kill him, because not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was also calling God his own Father, making himself equal to God. (John 5:18)

[Question] What did the Jewish religious leaders wrongly feel, was sound reason for the killing of Jesus Christ?

11. Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father. There is one that accuses you, Moses, in whom you have put your hope. (John 5:45)

[Question] Who did Jesus state, would later accuse these ones of wrongdoing, whom they stated that they followed?

12. I know that you are Abraham's offspring, but you are seeking to kill me, because my word makes no progress among you. (John 8:37)

[Question] Who were the Jews in fleshly relationship?

[Question] What though, did their trying to kill a righteous man, make them children of?
