

John 7:23~ If a man receives circumcision on a Sabbath, in order, that the Law of Moses may not be broken, are you violently angry at me, because I made a man completely sound in health on a Sabbath?

1· So Jesus reasoned, that if a man receives circumcision on the Sabbath, so that the Law of Moses might not be broken, then why were they angry at him for making a man completely sound in health on a Sabbath. Evidently this was the previously mentioned one deed, that he had performed at that festival, that they were finding fault with.

[Question] What then, did Jesus reason out with his opposers, concerning the circumcision performed on a Sabbath?

[Question] What deed had Jesus performed on the Sabbath, that they were finding fault with?

2· With that the man immediately became sound in health, and he picked up his cot and began to walk. Now on that day it was a Sabbath. (John 5:9)

[Question] What did the man Jesus healed do, upon being healed, and what day was it, when Jesus healed this man?

3· And an uncircumcised male who will not get the flesh of his foreskin circumcised, even that soul must be cut off from his people. He has broken my covenant. (Genesis 17:14)

[Question] What was a man who would not get himself circumcised considered to have done respecting this New Covenant given to Abraham, and how would he end up before God?

4· But the seventh day is a Sabbath to Yehowah your God. You must not do any work, you nor your son nor your daughter, your slave man nor your slave girl, nor your domestic animal, nor your alien resident who is inside your gates. (Exodus 20:10)

[Question] What were the Israelites told to abstain from on the Sabbath, and did this apply to everyone in Israel?

5· He, however, knew their reasonings, yet he said to the man with the withered hand; Get up and stand in the center. And he rose and took his stand. (Luke 6:8)

[Question] What did Jesus do on a Sabbath at a local synagogue?

[Question] Since the power to perform this fine work came forth from Yehowah God, what can we say about this, was it approved of by Yehowah God himself?

- 6· **So in response Jesus spoke to those versed in the Law, and to the Pharisees, saying; Is it lawful on the Sabbath to cure, or not? (Luke 14:3)**

[Question] What question did Jesus ask of the assembled scribes and Pharisees because he knew they were watching him to accuse him of wrongdoing?
