John 7:26~ And yet, see! He is speaking in public, and they say nothing to him. The rulers have not come to know for a certainty, that this is the Christ, have they?

1. So they were surprised, that the Jewish religious leaders were letting him speak openly in public. So they began to wonder if the Jewish religious leaders might not also be believing, that he was the Christ.

[Question] What then, were the people surprised to see him doing openly?

[Question] What did this cause them to ask inquiringly among themselves?

2. In that hour Jesus said to the crowds; Have you come out with swords and clubs as against a robber to arrest me? Day after day I used to sit in the temple teaching, and yet you did not take me into custody. (Matthew 26:55)

[Question] How did Jesus express surprise on the night of his arrest, at how they came out to arrest him?

3. Jesus answered him; I have spoken to the world publicly. I always taught in a synagogue and in the temple, where all the Jews come together, and I spoke nothing in secret. (John 18:20)

[Question] Where did Jesus speak and teach always, and did he have some secret agenda?

4. Not one of the rulers, or of the Pharisees, has put faith in him, has he? (John 7:48)

[Question] What though, did the ruling authority, the Pharisees, think of Jesus, because he openly criticized their way of worship?

5. Come here, see a man that told me all the things I did. This is not perhaps the Christ, is it? (John 4:29)

[Question] How did the Samaritan woman feel, after Jesus told her about her prior life course?
