[Question] What would remain within the tribe of Judah, and until when?

[Question] Who then, would the obedience of the people belong to?

- 4· And you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, the one too little to get to be among the thousands of Judah, from you there will come out to me, the one who is to become ruler in Israel, whose origin is from early times, from the days of time indefinite. ([Micah 5:2](#))**
