- Therefore Jesus cried out as he was teaching in the temple and said; You both know me and know where I am from. Also, I have not come of my own initiative, but he that sent me is real, and you do not know him.
 - 1. So Jesus, knowing their thoughts, spoke out boldly, saying, that they both knew him, and knew where he was from. He told them that he had not come forth to them of his own initiative. He was sent forth from God, who was a real and true God, yet one, that they had not come to know accurately, as he did.

[Question] What did Jesus then boldly say, to many gathered together there who knew him?

[Question] Who did Jesus then show was the true God, who had sent him forth?

- 2. This is the carpenter the son of Mary, and the brother of James and Joseph and Judas and Simon, is it not? And his sisters are here with us, are they not? So they began to stumble at him. (Mark 6:3)
 - [Question] How did many who knew Jesus and his family, stumble over his gifts and his teachings?
- 3. In answer Jesus said to them; Even if I do bear witness about myself, my witness is true, because I know where I came from, and where I am going. But you do not know where I came from, and where I am going. (John 8:14)
 - [Question] Why would the sole witness of Jesus Christ be true, for what special knowledge did he have of himself, that others failed to see?
- 4. Jesus said to them; If God were your Father, you would love me, for from God I came forth, and am here. Neither have I come of my own initiative at all, but that One sent me forth. (John 8:42)
 - [Question] What did Jesus tell these men that they would love, if they loved Yehowah God, for who send Jesus forth?
- 5. I have many things to speak concerning you and to pass judgment upon. As a matter of fact, he that sent me is true, and the very things I heard from him, I am speaking in the world. (John 8:26)

[Question] What things did Jesus always speak in the world, and where did he get these sayings from?

6. And yet you have not known him. But I know him. And if I said I do not know him, I should be like you, a liar. But I do know him, and am observing his word. (John 8:55)

[Question] What would Jesus have to make of himself, to deny that he knew Yehowah God intimately?

7. Jesus answered; If I glorify myself, my glory is nothing. It is my Father that glorifies me, he who you say is your God. (John 8:54)

[Question] Who glorified his son by calling him his son, and speaking thus from heaven on several occasions?

8. Moreover, without faith it is impossible to please him well, for he that approaches God must believe, that he is, and that he becomes, the rewarder of those earnestly seeking him. (Hebrews 11:6)

[Question] When is it impossible to please Yehowah God, for what must anyone approaching to God, believe about him?
