

John 7:3~ Therefore his brothers said to him; Pass on over from here and go into Judea, in order, that your disciples also may behold the works you do.

- 1· Therefore his fleshly brothers said to him, that he should pass on over and go into Judea, so that more people could see the fine works that he did.

[Question] What though, did Jesus' brothers want him to do, so that other people could see his fine works?

- 2· While he was yet speaking to the crowds, look! His mother and brothers took up a position outside, seeking to speak to him. (**Matthew 12:46**)

[Question] Who came on one occasion to speak to Jesus, while he was teaching others?

- 3· This is the carpenter the son of Mary and the brother of James and Joseph and Judas and Simon, is it not? And his sisters are here with us, are they not? So they began to stumble at him. (**Mark 6:3**)

[Question] Why did many stumble over Jesus, for what knowledge did they have of him?

- 4· Now his mother and brothers came toward him, but they were unable to get to him, because of the crowd. (**Luke 8:19**)

[Question] Why could Jesus' mother and brothers not get near to him on that occasion?

- 5· After this he and his mother and brothers and his **disciples** went down to Capernaum, but they did not stay there many days. (**John 2:12**)

[Question] Where did Jesus' mother and brothers travel, early in his ministry, to go and see him?

- 6· With one accord all these were persisting in prayer, together with some women and Mary the mother of Jesus and with his brothers. (**Acts of Apostles 1:14**)

[Question] Who were among the people gathered together for the outpouring of Holy Spirit at Pentecost?

- 7· **But I saw no one else of the apostles, only James the brother of the Lord. (Galatians 1:19)**

[Question] Who was a prominent member of the Jerusalem congregation in the **First Century C.E?**
