John 7:31~ Still, many of the crowd put faith in him, and they commenced saying; When the Christ arrives, he will not perform more signs than this man has performed, will he?

1. Still there were many within the crowds that were putting their faith in him, and they reasoned among themselves, that the Christ surely would not come forth with more signs from God, than this man had performed, for the works Jesus did, spoke volumes to reasoning people, that he was God's representative.

[Question] What though, did many more reasonable people within the crowds, reason out for themselves, and why?

2. However, when he was in Jerusalem at the Passover, at its festival, many people put their faith in his name, viewing his signs that he was performing. (John 2:23)

[Question] What happened when many saw Jesus' signs he performed at the Passover festival of the Jews?

3. As he was speaking these things, many put faith in him. (John 8:30)

[Question] What did many do after hearing Jesus speak and teach?

4. And many put faith in him there. (John 10:42)

[Question] What did many do after hearing Jesus teach?

5. Therefore many of the Jews that had come to Mary, and that beheld what he did, put faith in him. (John 11:45)

[Question] What did many of the Jews feel, upon seeing and hearing Jesus?

6. And he will certainly stand and do shepherding in the strength of Yehowah, in the superiority of the name of Yehowah his God. And they will certainly keep dwelling, for now he will be great as far as the ends of the earth. (Micah 5:4)

[Question] What did Micah state about the Messiah, and what work he would do within Israel?

7. Consequently the chief priests and the Pharisees gathered the Sanhedrin together, and began to say; What are we to

do, because this man performs many signs? (John 11:47)

[Question] What did the religious leaders of the Jews now gather together to do, and what did they express fear of?

8. And said to him; Are you the Coming One, or are we to expect a different one? (Matthew 11:3)

[Question] What was Jesus asked by the disciples of John the Baptist?

9. Well, all the crowds were simply carried away, and began to say; May this not perhaps be the Son of David? (Matthew 12:23)

[Question] What did many within the crowds say, upon seeing Jesus' miracles and hearing his teachings?

10" At that he did get up, and immediately picked up his cot, and walked out in front of them all, so that they were all simply carried away, and they glorified God, saying; We never saw the like of it. (Mark 2:12)

[Question] What did a crowd say, when Jesus healed a crippled man?

11. But I have the witness greater than that of John, for the very works that my Father assigned me to accomplish, the works themselves that I am doing, bear witness about me, that the Father dispatched me. (John 5:36)

[Question] What bore witness time and again that Jesus was from Yehowah God, his direct representative?

12. Because on account of him many of the Jews were going there, and putting faith in Jesus. (John 12:11)

[Question] How did the resurrection of Lazarus, affect many within Jerusalem?

13. If I had not done among them, the works that no one else did, they would have no sin, but now they have both seen and hated me, as well as my Father. (John 15:24)

[Question] What would be the case, if Jesus had not performed so many miracles among the Jews, but what did the Jew's rejection of Jesus show?
