

**John 7:34~** You will look for me, but you will not find me, and where I anymore, you cannot come.

- 1· Jesus then told them, that in that day, that they would look for him, but would not be able to find him then. This, because he was going away to a place, where they could not come to at present, to heaven.

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell them, that they would soon do, but what would they not find?

**[Question]** Where was Jesus then going, that they could not follow him to?

- 2· Hence he said to them again; I am going away, and you will look for me, and yet you will die in your sin. Where I am going you cannot come. (John 8:21)

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell the Jews, before he died, while in the temple treasury?

- 3· Therefore the Jews began to say; He will not kill himself, will he? Because he says; Where I am going you cannot come. (John 8:22)

**[Question]** What did the Jews think, that he meant to do, because he said he was going somewhere, that they could not follow him to?

- 4· Exert yourselves vigorously to get in through the narrow door, because many, I tell you, will seek to get in, but will not be able. (Luke 13:24)

**[Question]** What kind of effort did Jesus say to exercise, to gain the grand promises Yehowah God offers to his anointed Christian sons?

**[Question]** How would many people later come to feel, upon seeing what these sons attained to, that they themselves had lost?

- 5· Little children, I am with you a little longer. You will look for me, and just as I said to the Jews; Where I go you cannot come. I say also to you at present. (John 13:33)

**[Question]** What did Jesus later also tell his disciples, for where was he going then, and why could they not follow then?
