John 7:34~ You will look for me, but you will not find me, and where I anymore, you cannot come.

**1**. Jesus then told them, that in that day, that they would look for him, but would not be able to find him then. This, because he was going away to a place, where they could not come to at present, to heaven.

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell them, that they would soon do, but what would they not find?

[Question] Where was Jesus then going, that they could not follow him to?

2. Hence he said to them again; I am going away, and you will look for me, and yet you will die in your sin. Where I am going you cannot come. (John 8:21)

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell the Jews, before he died, while in the temple treasury?

3. Therefore the Jews began to say; He will not kill himself, will he? Because he says; Where I am going you cannot come. (John 8:22)

**[Question]** What did the Jews think, that he meant to do, because he said he was going somewhere, that they could not follow him to?

4. Exert yourselves vigorously to get in through the narrow door, because many, I tell you, will seek to get in, but will not be able. (Luke 13:24)

**[Question]** What kind of effort did Jesus say to exercise, to gain the grand promises Yehowah God offers to his anointed Christian sons?

**[Question]** How would many people later come to feel, upon seeing what these sons attained to, that they themselves had lost?

5. Little children, I am with you a little longer. You will look for me, and just as I said to the Jews; Where I go you cannot come. I say also to you at present. (John 13:33)

**[Question]** What did Jesus later also tell his disciples, for where was he going then, and why could they not follow then?
