

John 7:37~ Now on the last day, the great day of the festival, Jesus was standing up and he cried out, saying; **If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink.**

- 1· So on the very last day of the festival Jesus was standing up among the people and he cried out; **If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink.**

[Question] When now, did Jesus stand up among the people, and what did he say?

- 2· Seven **days** you should present an offering made by fire to Yehowah. On the eighth **day** there should occur a holy convention for you, and you must present an offering made by fire to Yehowah. It is a solemn assembly. No sort of laborious work may you do. (**Leviticus 23:36**)

[Question] What was to happen on the eighth day of the festival?

- 3· Hey there, all you **thirsty** ones! Come to the water. And the ones that have no money! Come, buy and eat. Yes, **come**, buy wine and milk even without money and without price. (**Isaiah 55:1**)

[Question] What open invitation does Isaiah make to the people of Israel, and what sustenance can they obtain without price?

- 4· Whoever **drinks** from the water that I will give him, will never get **thirsty** at all, but the water that I will give him, will become in him, a fountain of water, bubbling up, to impart everlasting life. (**John 4:14**)

[Question] What did Jesus state about the kind of water he could give to men, and what it would become within them, if they drank it down?

- 5· **Jesus** said to them; I am the bread of life. He that **comes** to me will not get hungry at all, and he that exercises faith in me will never get **thirsty** at all. (**John 6:35**)

[Question] What did Jesus tell people, that he was like from Yehowah God, and what would people experience, who put their faith in him?

- 6· And the spirit and the bride keep on **saying**; Come! And **let anyone** hearing say; Come! And **let anyone** thirsting **come**. **Let anyone** that wishes take life's water free. (**Revelation**)

[Question] What open invitation is made to all spiritually thirsting ones in the Revelation account?

- 7· Also, the **festival** of harvest of the first ripe fruits of your labors, of what you sow in the field, and the **festival** of ingathering at the outgoing of the year, when you gather in your labors from the field. (**Exodus 23:16**)

[Question] When was the festival of Booths held, and what did it signify?

- 8· On the first **day** is a holy convention. No sort of laborious work may you do. (**Leviticus 23:35**)

[Question] What was not to be done on the first and eighth days of this solemn assembly?

- 9· And there was a reading aloud of the book of the Law of the true God, **day** by **day**, from the first **day** until the last **day**, and they went on holding the **festival** seven **days**, and on the eighth **day** there was a solemn assembly, according to the rule. (**Nehemiah 8:18**)

[Question] What was commonly done throughout this festival, to educate the people or Israel?

- 10· In answer **Jesus** said to her; **If** you had known the free gift of God, and who it is that says to you; Give me a drink. You would have asked him, and he would have given you living water. (**John 4:10**)

[Question] What did Jesus state, that he would have given to the Samaritan woman, if she had known who he was?

- 11· For truly by one spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to **drink** one spirit. (**1 Corinthians 12:13**)

[Question] How are all men and women baptized into Christ, and what do all of them drink?
