John 7:46~ The officers replied; Never has another man spoken like this.

1. So they replied, that never before had another man spoken like Jesus spoke. They too, were impressed by Jesus' words and teachings. This only angered the religious leaders even further.

[Question] What did these ones then reply in their defense, for how did Jesus speak?

[Question] What did this cause the religious leaders to do even more?

2. Naphtali is a slender hind. He is giving words of elegance. (Genesis 49:21)

[Question] What blessing did Naphtali receive from his father Jacob?

3. For he was teaching them as a person having authority, and not as their scribes. (Matthew 7:29)

[Question] How did Jesus teach, that was different than the scribes?

4. And they all began to give favorable witness about him, and to marvel at the winsome words proceeding out of his mouth, and they were saying; This is a son of Joseph, is it not? (Luke 4:22)

[Question] How did the people of his hometown feel, and what did they say upon hearing the wisdom of Jesus?

5. In response some of the scribes said; Teacher, you spoke well. (Luke 20:39)

[Question] What did even some of his opposers think, after hearing what he had to say?

6. And I did not put faith in the words until I had come, that my own eyes might see, and, look! I had not been told the half. You have surpassed in wisdom and prosperity the things heard, to which I listened. (1 Kings 10:7)

[Question] Who did the Queen of Sheba feel, after coming far to hear the wisdom of Solomon?

7' You are indeed more handsome than the sons of men. Charm has been poured out upon your lips. That is why God has blessed you to time indefinite. (Psalms 45:2) [Question] How did the Psalmist bless this special son prophetically?

8. For they are a wreath of attractiveness to your head, and a fine necklace to your throat. (Proverbs 1:9)

[Question] What are words of wisdom like to those keeping them, in the eyes of others?

9. For his mouth of discretion, a man will be praised, but one who is twisted at heart, will come to be for contempt. (Proverbs 12:8)

[Question] Why will a man come to be praised?

10" The tongue of wise ones does good with knowledge, but the mouth of the stupid ones bubbles forth with foolishness. (Proverbs 15:2)

[Question] How does the tongue of wise ones handle knowledge?

11. The Sovereign Lord Yehowah himself has given me the tongue of the taught ones, that I may know how to answer the tired one with a word. He awakens morning by morning, he awakens my ear to hear like the taught ones. (Isaiah 50:4)

[Question] What did Isaiah prophesy, that Yehowah God would give to his Messiah, and for what purpose?

12. And they were astounded at his way of teaching, because his speech was with authority. (Luke 4:32)

[Question] How did people feel when hearing Jesus teach?

13. This one came to him in the night and said to him; Rabbi, we know that you as a teacher have come from God, for no one can perform these signs that you perform unless God is with him. (John 3:2)

[Question] What did Nicodemus tell Jesus, that the Pharisees realized about Jesus, and why?

14. However, when he said to them; I am he, they drew back and fell to the ground. (John 18:6)

[Question] How did the men react who came to arrest Jesus when he openly told them he was the one they were looking for?
