1· Now Nicodemus who had come earlier to Jesus and spoken to him personally, tried to temper their opinion of Jesus, for he knew him to be a fine man.

[Question] Who then, spoke up in favor of Jesus, for what did Nicodemus know Jesus to be, from firsthand knowledge?

2· Now there was a man of the Pharisees, Nicodemus was his name, a ruler of the Jews. (John 3:1)

[Question] Who earlier had come to Jesus and spoken with him at length?

3· Nicodemus also, the man that came to him in the night the first time, came bringing a roll of myrrh and aloes, about a hundred pounds of it. (John 19:39)

[Question] Who also was among the two men, who later gave Jesus an honorable burial?
