1· So he replied to them, that his due time was not yet at hand, so then he would not go up to the festival at this time. Yet their due time was always at hand, for the moment of their death was something unknown, whereas his was pre-determined.

2· But Jesus said to her; What have I to do with you, woman? My hour has not yet come. (John 2:4)

3· Hence they began seeking to get hold of him, but no one laid a hand upon him, because his hour had not yet come. (John 7:30)
