

John 7:8~

You go up to the festival. I am not yet going up to this festival, because my due time has not yet fully come.

- 1· So he told his brothers to go up to the festival by themselves, for it was not the time for him to go, because his time had not yet fully come.**

[Question] What then, did Jesus counsel his brothers to do, and what would he do later?

[Question] What may Jesus have feared would happen to his family, if they were seen at the festival with him?

- 2· Then he came to the disciples and said to them; At such a time as this you are sleeping and taking your rest! Look! The hour **has** drawn near for the Son of man to be betrayed into the hands of sinners. (**Matthew 26:45**)**

[Question] How did Jesus feel later, when he was betrayed by Judas Iscariot?

- 3· These sayings he spoke in the treasury as he was teaching in the temple. But no one laid hold of him, because his hour had not yet come. (**John 8:20**)**

[Question] Though the Jewish religious leaders were seeking to kill Jesus for quite some time, why could they not do so?

- 4· A time for birth and a time to die. A time to plant and a time to uproot what was planted. (**Ecclesiastes 3:2**)**

[Question] What things are there a time for in life?
