

John 8:12~ Therefore Jesus spoke again to them, saying; **I am the light of the world. He that follows me, will by no means walk in darkness, but will possess the light of life.**

1· Therefore Jesus spoke again to them, saying; **I, am the light of the world. Then he promised them, that anyone following after him, would by no means walk in darkness, for he would possess the light of life, the Holy Spirit. This spirit would guide and direct his followers and disciples, to do the will of Yehowah God, henceforth.**

[Question] What did Jesus call himself, and what would men following him not walk in?

[Question] What then, is this light of life?

[Question] How would this light of life make Jesus' followers walk in the future?

2· The people that were walking in the **darkness** have seen a great **light**. As for those dwelling in the land of deep shadow, **light** itself has shone upon them. (**Isaiah 9:2**)

[Question] What did Isaiah prophesy about the people of the land of Galilee, and who fulfilled this prophecy?

3· And he proceeded to say; **It has been more than a trivial matter for you to become my servant, to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to bring back even the safeguarded ones of Israel. I, also, have given you for a light of the nations, that my salvation may come to be to the extremity of the earth. (Isaiah 49:6)**

[Question] Was the bringing forth of the Messiah a major part of Yehowah God's grand purpose for mankind?

[Question] What would this one prove to be toward the nations, and where would the salvation of Yehowah God extend to through him?

4· The people sitting in **darkness** saw a great **light**, and as for those sitting in a region of deathly shadow, **light** rose upon them. (**Matthew 4:16**)

[Question] What prophecy did Matthew quote, to show where this light would, and did, shine?

5· And the **light** is shining in the **darkness**, but the **darkness**

has not overpowered it. (**John 1:5**)

[Question] What did Jesus state about his spiritual light, and what would not be able to overpower it?

- 6· Jesus therefore said to them; The **light will** be among you a little while longer. Walk while you have the **light**, so that **darkness** does not overpower you. He that **walks** in the **darkness**, does not know where he is going. (**John 12:35**)

[Question] What light did Jesus state would be among them only a little while longer, and so how should they walk while they had it among them?

- 7· Therefore you men **will** have night, so that there **will** be no vision, and **darkness** you **will** have, so as not to practice divination. And the sun **will** certainly set upon the prophets, and the day must get dark upon them. (**Micah 3:6**)

[Question] What did Micah state would come upon the prophets of Israel?

- 8· I have come as a **light** into the **world**, in order, that everyone putting faith in me, may not remain in the **darkness**. (**John 12:46**)

[Question] How did Jesus come forth into the world, and for what purpose?

- 9· But you are, a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for special possession, that you should declare abroad the excellencies, of the one that called you out of **darkness**, into his wonderful **light**. (**1 Peter 2:9**)

[Question] What are anointed Christians called out of this world of spiritual darkness, to do?

- 10· Again, I **am** writing you a new commandment, a fact that is true in his case, and in yours, because the **darkness** is passing away, and the true **light** is already shining. (**1 John 2:8**)

[Question] What was already being dispelled, by the glorious spiritual light of the Messiah, in Jesus' day?

- 11· I myself, Yehowah, have called you in righteousness, and I

proceeded to take hold of your hand. And I shall safeguard you and give you as a covenant of the people, as a **light** of the nations. (**Isaiah 42:6**)

[Question] What did Yehowah God call forth his Messiah to be, and what would he serve as, toward his people Israel, and to the nations?

12· You are the **light** of the **world**. A city cannot be hid when situated upon a mountain (**Matthew 5:14**)

[Question] What are anointed Christians within this spiritual darkness of Satan the Devil's world?

[Question] Where then, should they position their spiritual lights?

13· By **means** of him was life, and the life was the **light** of men. (**John 1:4**)

[Question] What comes through Jesus Christ, and what was this life to mankind?

14· Now this is the basis for judgment, that the **light** has come into the **world**, but men have loved the **darkness**, rather than the **light**, for their works were wicked. (**John 3:19**)

[Question] What is the basis for judgment, within this Satan the Devil's world?

15· As long as I **am** in the **world**, I **am** the world's **light**. (**John 9:5**)

[Question] What was Jesus, as long as he was in this world?

16· To open their eyes, to turn them from **darkness** to **light**, and from the authority of Satan, to God, in order for them to receive forgiveness of sins, and an inheritance, among those, sanctified by their faith in me. (**Acts of Apostles 26:18**)

[Question] What is the purpose of the preaching of the Good News of God's Kingdom?

17· Among whom the god of this system of things has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, that the illumination of the glorious Good News about the Christ, who is the image of God, might not shine through. (**2 Corinthians 4:4**)

[Question] What had the god of this system of things done to people's eyes within this system of things, for what does he not want them to see?

- 18· Wherefore he says; **Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and the Christ will shine upon you. (Ephesians 5:14)**

[Question] What scripture did Paul quote, and what does it show about this great light from God?

- 19· For you are all sons of **light** and sons of day. We belong neither to night, nor to **darkness. (1 Thessalonians 5:5)**

[Question] What kind of sons are anointed Christian sons of God?

- 20· And the nations **will walk by means** of its **light**, and the kings of the earth **will bring their glory into it. (Revelation 21:24)**

[Question] What light will the New Jerusalem bring to mankind, for what spiritual lights will reside within it?
