

John 8:14~ In answer Jesus said to them; Even if I do bear witness¹ about myself, my witness is true, because I know where I came from, and where I am going. But you do not know where I came from, and where I am going.

1· So in answer Jesus said to them, that even if he did bear witness about himself, that did not make his witness untrue, for he knew where he came from, and where he was going to. He had come forth from God, and was soon to return to him. They, on the other hand, did not know where he was from, as evidenced by their earlier statements, nor where he was going, back to the heavens to his heavenly Father.

[Question] How did Jesus then answer them to show that his witness, though coming from himself, was nonetheless true?

[Question] What did he know about himself, that they failed to realize?

2· If I alone bear witness about myself, my witness is not true. (John 5:31)

[Question] What did Jesus tell them would be the case, if he was the only one to bear witness about himself?

3· Therefore Jesus cried out as he was teaching in the temple, and said; You both know me, and know where I am from. Also, I have not come of my own initiative, but he that sent me is real, and you do not know him. (John 7:28)

[Question] What did Jesus then tell crowds of people, as to where he was from, and who had sent him forth?

4· He, knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he came forth from God, and was going to God. (John 13:3)

[Question] What did Jesus know about himself, and where he was going after death?

5· I came out from the Father and have come into the world. Further, I am leaving the world, and am going my way to the Father. (John 16:28)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples, as to where he had come from, and was going to in the future?

6· **We know that God has spoken to Moses, but as for this man, we do not know where he is from. (John 9:29)**

[Question] What did the Jews believe in, and why?

[Question] Did those Jews see any of the works of Moses themselves?

[Question] Did Jesus perform many more miracles than did Moses, and did the Jews of his day actually seem any of these miracles?
