

John 8:15~

You judge according to the flesh. I do not judge any man at all.

1· Then he told them, that they judged according to the flesh, and according to what things they saw in the flesh. He on the other hand did not judge any man at all. They were in fact stumbling over him, because of their very rush, or haste, to come to judgment.

[Question] How did Jesus show them, how they judged matters?

[Question] What did Jesus then show, that he did not do at all?

[Question] Why were they in fact stumbling over him?

2· But Yehowah said to Samuel; Do not look at his appearance and at the height of his stature, for I have rejected him. For not the way man sees, is the way God sees, because mere man sees what appears to the eyes. But as for Yehowah, he sees what the heart is. (1 Samuel 16:7)

[Question] What did Yehowah God tell Samuel, about the ones Samuel thought should be king of Israel?

[Question] What does Yehowah God look for in a man?

3· Stop judging from the outward appearance, but judge with righteous judgment. (John 7:24)

[Question] What judgment did Jesus tell his disciples to stop judging with, for how should they judge?

4· He said to him; Man, who appointed me judge or apportioner over you persons? (Luke 12:14)

[Question] What did Jesus tell a man, who wanted him to become a judge of his inheritance?

5· For God sent forth his Son into the world, not for him to judge the world, but for the world to be saved through him. (John 3:17)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God send forth Jesus into the world?

6· But if anyone hears my sayings and does not keep them, I do not judge him, for I came, not to judge the world, but to save the world. (John 12:47)

[Question] What did Jesus state about anyone hearing his words and not doing them?
