John 8:17~ Also, in your own Law it is written: The witness of two men is true.

1. So Jesus then showed them, that it was written in the Law Covenant, that the witness of two men is true.

[Question] What did Jesus show, that the Law Covenant bore witness to, as being true?

2. At the mouth of two witnesses, or of three witnesses, the one dying should be put to death. He will not be put to death, at the mouth of one witness. (Deuteronomy 17:6)

[Question] What was required for a man to be put to death, over any serious matter under the Law Covenant?

3. No single witness should rise up against a man respecting any error or any sin, in the case of any sin that he may commit. At the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, the matter should stand good.

(Deuteronomy 19:15)

[Question] What would a single witness not be sufficient to do under the Law Covenant, for what confirmed a matter as true?

4. But if he does not listen, take along with you one or two more, in order, that at the mouth of two or three witnesses, every matter may be established. (Matthew 18:16)

**[Question]** How should matters of judgment within the Christian congregation be handled?

5. This is the third time I am coming to you. At the mouth of two witnesses or of three, every matter must be established. (2 Corinthians 13:1)

[Question] What did Paul use to show that three visits by him, should be enough for them to understand and practice his teachings?

6 Any man that has disregarded the Law of Moses, dies without compassion, upon the testimony of two or three. (Hebrews 10:28)

[Question] What happens to a lawbreaker, when two or three witnesses arise against him under the Law Covenant?

7. Every fatal striker of a soul should be slain as a murderer at the mouth of witnesses, and one witness may not testify against a soul for him to die. (Numbers 35:30)

[Question] What was to be done to murderers under the Law Covenant?

[Question] Could one witness alone condemn a man?

8. And I will cause my two witnesses to prophesy a thousand two hundred and sixty days dressed in sackcloth. (Revelation 11:3)

[Question] Who comes forth in the Lord's day bearing witness, and how long do they prophesy for?
