

John 8:18~ I am one that bears witness about myself, and the Father who sent me, bears witness about me.

1· So Jesus showed them, that there were in fact two witnesses to what he had said, for the Father himself had borne witness about him, that he was his son and representative, and many people had heard his voice thus declaring him to be his son. Also, through every miraculous work he performed, his Father continued to bear witness of his approval through his supplying the power to accomplish them.

[Question] What then, did Jesus show them, that had borne witness about himself?

[Question] What witness was present then with every fine work Jesus performed, for who supplied the power to do these things?

2· Also, the Father who sent me has himself borne witness about me. You have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his figure. (John 5:37)

[Question] Who did Jesus state had borne witness about him, and his works among the people of Israel?

3· For he received from God the Father honor and glory, when words such as these were borne to him by the magnificent glory; This is my son, my beloved, whom I myself have approved. (2 Peter 1:17)

[Question] What words did three of his disciples bear witness to hearing from heaven, in the mountain of transfiguration?

4· Look! Also, there was a voice from the heavens that said; This is my Son, the beloved, whom I have approved. (Matthew 3:17)

[Question] What voice was heard by many from heaven at Jesus' baptism?

5· If we receive the witness men give, the witness God gives is greater, because this is the witness God gives, the fact that he has borne witness concerning his Son. (1 John 5:9)

[Question] Whose witness in these matters, bore the most weight, and why?
