

John 8:19~

Therefore they went on to say to him; Where is your Father? Jesus answered; You know neither me nor my Father. If you did know me, you would know my Father also.

1· So Jesus answered, that they knew neither his Father nor him, for if they knew him, then they would also know his Father, because he was just like him spiritually.

[Question] What did Jesus then tell his opposers that they did not know?

[Question] Why would they know the father, if they knew Jesus?

2· But they will do these things, because they have not come to know either the Father or me. (John 16:3)

[Question] Why would these men come to do all these things to Jesus and later to his disciples?

3· All things have been delivered to me by my Father, and no one fully knows the Son, but the Father, neither does anyone fully know the Father, but the Son, and anyone, to whom the Son is willing to reveal him. (Matthew 11:27)

[Question] Whom did Jesus state knew him the best, and who did Jesus know better than any other man alive?

4· If you men had known me, you would have known my Father also, from this moment on, you know him, and have seen him. (John 14:7)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples later, as to knowing the Father?
