1· Now these things Jesus spoke in the treasury while he was teaching in the temple area. Yet despite the fact, that they wanted to lay hold of Jesus to destroy him, they could not effect it, for it was not yet his due time.

[Question] Where was Jesus, while he was teaching these things?

[Question] What then, did the religious leaders want to do, but why could they not accomplish this?

2· And he sat down with the **treasury** chests in view, and began observing, how the crowd was dropping money into the **treasury** chests, and many rich people were dropping in many coins. (**Mark 12:41**)

[Question] Where then, did Jesus sit down, and what activity was he carefully watching?

3· Hence they began seeking to get **hold** of him, but no one **laid** a hand upon him, because his **hour** had not yet **come**. (**John 7:30**)

[Question] Why were the religious leaders thwarted in their attempts to get hold of Jesus then?

4· You go up to the festival. I am not yet going up to this festival, because my due time has not yet fully **come**. (**John 7:8**)

[Question] Why did Jesus postpone his arrival at the festival of the Jews?
