

**John 8:21~** Hence he said to them again; **I am going away, and you will look for me, and yet you will die in your sin. Where I am going, you cannot come.**

**1· So once again he said to them that he was going away, and that many of them would indeed look for him. Yet many also would die in their sins over their rejection of him. Also he told them, that where he was going, they could not come.**

**[Question]** What did Jesus then tell his listeners, that he was going to do?

**[Question]** In the interim, what would many of them do, before they ever saw him again?

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell them, about where he was going?

**2· You go up to the festival. I **am** not yet **going** up to this festival, because my due time has not yet fully come. (John 7:8)**

**[Question]** Why did Jesus not go up to that festival of the Jews, when his brothers went up?

**3· You **will look** for me, but you **will** not find me, and where I **am** you cannot come. (John 7:34)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell his listeners, that they would look for, but not be able to find, for where was he going?

**4· Little children, I **am** with you a little longer. You **will look** for me, and just as I said to the Jews; Where I go, you cannot come. I say also to you at present. (John 13:33)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell his disciples that he was going and why they could not follow at present?

**5· Therefore I said to you, you **will die** in your sins. For if you do not believe that I **am** he, you **will die** in your sins. (John 8:24)**

**[Question]** What would happen to anyone not believing that Jesus was the Messiah?
