John 8:26~ I have many things to speak concerning you, and to pass judgment upon. As a matter of fact, he that sent me is true, and the very things I heard from him, I am speaking in the world.

1. So he told them plainly, that he had many other things to speak concerning them and to pass judgment upon. Then he told them, that the one who had sent him forth into the world, was true, and everything that he spoke to them, came forth from that one.

[Question] What matters did he then tell them, that he needed to speak to them?

[Question] What did he tell them, about the one that had sent him forth?

2. Therefore Jesus cried out as he was teaching in the temple and said; You both know me and know where I am from. Also, I have not come of my own initiative, but he that sent me is real, and you do not know him. (John 7:28)

[Question] What did Jesus cry out, as he was in the temple?

3. Jesus answered him; I have spoken to the world publicly. I always taught in a synagogue and in the temple, where all the Jews come together, and I spoke nothing in secret. (John 18:20)

[Question] What did Jesus reveal, about how, and where, he always taught people?

4. Most truly I say to you, what we know we speak, and what we have seen we bear witness of, but you people do not receive the witness we give. (John 3:11)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his listeners, that people speak and bear witness about?

[Question] Though Jesus knew Yehowah God and spoke his words, how did men respond to this?

5' What he has seen and heard, of this he bears witness, but no man is accepting his witness. (John 3:32)

[Question] What things did Jesus make known to men on earth, about what he had seen in heaven, yet how was their received?

6. But now you are seeking to kill me, a man that has told you the truth that I heard from God. Abraham did not do this. (John 8:40)

[Question] How did Jesus fare by telling the truth about the things he heard from Yehowah God, before his Jewish brothers?

[Question] Whose faith were such men not imitating?

7. Never may that happen! But let God be found true, though every man be found a liar, even as it is written: That you might be proved righteous in your words and might win when you are being judged. (Romans 3:4)

[Question] What did Paul state about the witness of every man, when held against the witness of God?
