

John 8:29~ **And he that sent me is with me. He did not abandon me to myself, because I always do the things pleasing to him.**

1· Then Jesus showed them, that his God and Father was with him, in all that he did and said. Yehowah God never abandoned him, because he did the will of his heavenly Father always, and not his own will.

[Question] Why did Yehowah God never abandon Jesus to himself?

2· The fear of Yehowah means the hating of bad. Self-exaltation and pride, and the bad way, and the perverse mouth, I have hated. (Proverbs 8:13)

[Question] What does the fear of Yehowah God mean, for what things does Yehowah God hate?

3· Jesus said to them; My food is for me to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work. (John 4:34)

[Question] What did Jesus consider to be like daily food for him to do?

4· Do you not believe that I am in union with the Father, and the Father is in union with me? The things I say to you men, I do not speak of my own originality, but the Father, who remains in union with me, is doing his works. (John 14:10)

[Question] What did Jesus always speak, and where did the things he spoke originate with?

5· You loved righteousness, and you hated lawlessness. That is why God, your God, anointed you with the oil of exultation more than your partners. (Hebrews 1:9)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God anoint his Messiah more than any of his partners, or anointed Christian sons of God?

6· And Isaac began to say to Abraham his father; My father! In turn he said; Here I am, my son! So he continued; Here are the fire and the wood, but where is the sheep for the burnt offering? (Genesis 22:7)

[Question] How was the offering of Isaac, pictorial of the offering of Jesus Christ?

- 7· **If you observe my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I have observed the commandments of the Father, and remain in his love. (John 15:10)**

[Question] What does one have to do, to remain in Yehowah God's love, and how did Jesus do this?

- 8· **Look! The hour is coming, indeed, it has come, when you will be scattered each one to his own house, and you will leave me alone. Yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me. (John 16:32)**

[Question] What hour did Jesus tell his disciples was fast approaching, and who would they fare then?

[Question] Was Jesus though, ever alone, even when his disciples left him?

- 9· **He was faithful to the One that made him such, as Moses was also in all the house of that One. (Hebrews 3:2)**

[Question] Who was Jesus always faithful to, like Moses?
