^{John 8:31~} And so Jesus went on to say to the Jews that had believed him; If you remain in my word, you are really my disciples.

1 So to those who did believe him, Jesus told them, that to be one of his disciples, that they would have to remain in his word, holding fast to what he taught, and putting it into practice.

[Question] What then, does it mean, to keep doing this, in remembrance of Jesus?

2. And you do not have his word remaining in you, because the very one whom he dispatched, you do not believe.

3. If you remain in union with me, and my sayings remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will take place for you. (John 15:7)

[Question] What confidence do anointed Christians have, if they remain in union with Yehowah God and his Christ?

4 Because of the truth that remains in us, and it will be with us forever. (2 John 1:2)

[Question] What remains in anointed Christians through their spirit anointing, and how long will it remain within them?
