

John 8:32~

And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.

1• **So, to those doing so, he told them that they would come to know the truth, and that the truth would come to set them free. It would free them from many religious falsehoods and religious traditions that bound them fast. They would then come to know the truth, for God's word the Bible, the Holy Scriptures, is the truth about God and his purposes. Also his Holy Spirit is described as the spirit of the truth.**

[Question] What did Jesus then tell his disciples, that they would come to know, and what would it set them free from?

[Question] What two things then, would keep them on a course to their heavenly Father?

2• **Sanctify them by means of the truth. Your word is truth. (John 17:17)**

[Question] What sanctifies anointed Christians, and where do we find this truth?

3• **Therefore Pilate said to him; Well, then, are you a king? Jesus answered; You yourself are saying that I am a king. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone that is on the side of the truth, listens to my voice. (John 18:37)**

[Question] What did Jesus reveal to Pilate was the very reason why he had come forth to the earth?

[Question] Who listens to the saying of Jesus Christ?

4• **And I will walk about in a roomy place, for I have searched even for your orders. (Psalms 119:45)**

[Question] How did the Psalmist feel about keeping the orders and commands of Yehowah God?

5• **Yehowah's spirit is upon me, because he anointed me to declare Good News to the poor, he sent me forth to preach a release to the captives and a recovery of sight to the blind, to send the crushed ones away with a release. (Luke 4:18)**

[Question] What commission was the Christ given to preach and teach, and toward whom?

- 6· **For sin must not be master over you, seeing that you are not under Law but under undeserved kindness. (Romans 6:14)**

[Question] What must not be the master over anointed Christians, for what are they now under, rather than the Law Covenant?

- 7· **However, now, because you were set free from sin, but became slaves to God, you are having your fruit in the way of holiness, and the end everlasting life. (Romans 6:22)**

[Question] What are anointed Christians enjoying, now that they have been set free from sin, and what fruitage do they bring forth?

- 8· **And that he might emancipate all those who for fear of death were subject to slavery all through their lives. (Hebrews 2:15)**

[Question] Who does Jesus Christ set free, for what held them captive prior to his coming?

- 9· **Instruct me, O Yehowah, about your way. I shall walk in your truth. Unify my heart to fear your name. (Psalms 86:11)**

[Question] What did the Psalmist ask Yehowah God to instruct him in, and why?

- 10· **Buy truth itself and do not sell it, wisdom and discipline and understanding. (Proverbs 23:23)**

[Question] What do the Proverbs encourage us to buy, and not to sell out?

- 11· **For her sins have massed together clear up to heaven, and God has called her acts of injustice to mind. (Revelation 18:5)**

[Question] Whose sins have massed together clear up to heaven?

- 12· **To say to the prisoners; Come out! To those who are in the darkness; Reveal yourselves! By the ways they will pasture, and on all beaten paths their pasturing will be. (Isaiah 49:9)**

[Question] What role does the Messiah play before God, and where does he lead God's people?

- 13· And he continued saying to me; Son of man, go, enter in among the house of Israel, and you must speak with my words to them. (**Ezekiel 3:4**)

[Question] Whose words was the son, Ezekiel, told to tell to the men of Israel?

- 14· And they **will** no longer defile themselves with their dungy idols, and with their disgusting things, and with all their transgressions, and I shall certainly save them from all their dwelling places in which they have sinned, and I **will** cleanse them, and they must become my people, and I myself shall become their God. (**Ezekiel 37:23**)

[Question] What did Yehowah God promise to do for his people through Ezekiel?

- 15· And as a grain offering you should provide with it, morning by morning, the sixth of an ephah, and, as regards oil, the third of a hin, for sprinkling the fine flour. The grain offering to Yehowah is an indefinitely lasting statute, constantly. (**Ezekiel 46:14**)

[Question] What was the constant offering daily at the temple of Yehowah God in Jerusalem?

- 16· Because the Law was given through Moses, the undeserved kindness and the **truth**, came to be through Jesus Christ. (**John 1:17**)

[Question] What was given through Moses, and what finer things came through Jesus Christ?

- 17· Even those who exchanged the **truth** of God for the lie, and venerated and rendered sacred service to the creation, rather than the One who created, who is blessed forever. Amen. (**Romans 1:25**)

[Question] What have men then, and today, exchanged the truth of Yehowah God for, through teachings like evolution, and who do they render sacred service to now?

- 18· Yes, since you were **set** free from sin, you became slaves to righteousness. (**Romans 6:18**)

[Question] What must anointed Christians become slaves to, now that they are set free from sin?

- 19· For the Law of that spirit, which gives life in union with Christ Jesus, has **set** you free from the Law of sin and of death. (**Romans 8:2**)

[Question] What Law sets anointed Christians free from the Law of sin and death?

- 20· That the creation itself also **will be set** free from enslavement to corruption, and have the glorious freedom of the children of God. (**Romans 8:21**)

[Question] What is the promise for the future for all creation from Yehowah God?

- 21· But because of the false brothers brought in quietly, who sneaked in to spy upon our freedom, which we have in union with Christ Jesus, that they might completely enslave us. (**Galatians 2:4**)

[Question] What did many come into the anointed Christian congregation to do, in the **First Century C.E?**

- 22· For such freedom Christ **set** us free. Therefore stand fast, and do not let yourselves be confined again in a yoke of slavery. (**Galatians 5:1**)

[Question] What did Jesus Christ set men free for, and so what things should anointed Christians resist going back to?

- 23· However, we are obligated to thank God always for you, brothers loved by Yehowah, because God selected you from the beginning for salvation by sanctifying you with spirit and by your faith in the **truth**. (**2 Thessalonians 2:13**)

[Question] Who selected all anointed Christians, and how does he sanctify them in two ways?

- 24· Paul, a slave of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's chosen ones, and the accurate knowledge of the **truth**, which accords with godly devotion (**Titus 1:1**)

[Question] What does an accurate knowledge of the truth accord with?

- 25· I write you, not because you do not **know** the **truth**, but because you **know** it, and because no lie originates with the **truth**. (1 John 2:21)

[Question] What did Paul show about anointed Christians he wrote his letters to?

[Question] What never originates with the truth?

- 26· The older man to the chosen lady and to her children, whom I truly love, and not I alone, but all those also, who have come to **know** the **truth**. (2 John 1:1)

[Question] What was a distinguishing mark of **First Century** Christianity?

- 27· So you, also, have those holding fast the teaching of the sect of Nicolaus likewise. (Revelation 2:15)

[Question] What did Jesus reveal through the Revelation account, had come into the Christian congregation?

- 28· And they conquered him because of the blood of the Lamb, and because of the word of their witnessing, and they did not love their souls, even in the face of death. (Revelation 12:11)

[Question] How do anointed Christians conquer, and what do they place as more important, than even their own lives?
