John 8:34~ Jesus answered them; Most truly I say to you, every doer of sin, is a slave of sin.

1. So Jesus said to them, that every doer of sin, was also a slave of sin. So then, because they were all sinful, they were all slaves to sin, with only death as the end of in view. They were not free to live forever.

[Question] What then, did Jesus state, that every doer of sin was, and why?

[Question] What then, were they not free to do?

2. His own errors will catch the wicked one, and in the ropes of his own sin, he will be taken hold of. (Proverbs 5:22)

[Question] What will catch up with the wicked ones in time?

3. Because we know that our old personality was impaled with him, that our sinful body might be made inactive, that we should no longer go on being slaves to sin. (Romans 6:6)

[Question] What was impaled along with Christ for anointed Christians, and so what must they no longer be slaves to?

4. Do you not know, that if you keep presenting yourselves to anyone, as slaves to obey him, you are slaves of him, because you obey him, either of sin with death in view, or of obedience, with righteousness in view? (Romans 6:16)

[Question] What are you, if you present your bodies to anyone to obey him?

[Question] What then, results from slaving for sin?

[Question] What then, results from slaving for righteousness?

5. For we know that the Law is spiritual, but I am fleshly, sold under sin. (Romans 7:14)

[Question] What are all humans, though existing under a spiritual Law from Yehowah God?

6' While they are promising them freedom, they themselves are existing as slaves of corruption. For whoever is overcome by another, is enslaved by this one. (2 Peter 2:19)

[Question] What do men promise one another, yet what are they themselves slaves of?

7. And you people will certainly say; The way of Yehowah is not adjusted right. Hear, please, O house of Israel. Is not my own way adjusted right? Are not the ways of you people not adjusted right? (Ezekiel 18:25)

[Question] When men and Yehowah God disagree, who is always in the right?

8 For when you were slaves of sin, you were free as to righteousness. (Romans 6:20)

[Question] What were anointed Christians free of, when they slaved for sin, before becoming anointed Christians?

9. But I behold in my members another Law warring against the Law of my mind, and leading me captive to sin's law, that is in my members. (Romans 7:23)

[Question] What force or Law did Paul find warring against his desire to do what was right?
