<sup>John 8:35~</sup> Moreover, the slave does not remain in the household forever. The son remains forever.

## **1**. Then Jesus also showed them, that as slaves within Yehowah God's household, they would not remain forever. Yet the Son of God would, for he was the heir of God.

**[Question]** What would not remain within Yehowah God's household forever, and who would?

[Question] What was Jesus Christ within that household of Yehowah God?

2. So she began to say to Abraham; Drive out this slave girl and her son, for the son of this slave girl, is not going to be an heir with my son, with Isaac! (Genesis 21:10)

[Question] What happened with the drama of Abraham and Sarah to show that the slave Ishmael, who represented Fleshly Israel, would not inherit alongside of the free man Isaac?

3. But to the sons of the concubines that Abraham had Abraham gave gifts. Then he sent them away from Isaac his son, while he was still alive, eastward, to the land of the East. (Genesis 25:6)

[Question] What did Abraham give to his concubines and their sons?

[Question] Who alone inherited from Abraham, and who is the Greater Isaac?

4. Nevertheless, what does the Scripture say: Drive out the servant girl, and her son, for by no means shall the son of the servant girl be an heir with the son of the free woman. (Galatians 4:30)

[Question] What does the scripture state regarding this future inheritance, and who would receive it?

5. Now this Hagar means Sinai, a mountain in Arabia, and she corresponds with the Jerusalem today, for she is in slavery with her children. (Galatians 4:25)

[Question] What did Paul show, that this Hagar represented, and what was her condition then?
