What things I have seen with my Father, I speak, and you, therefore, do the things you have heard from your father.

- 1· Jesus then told them, that the things that he had received from his Father, were what same things he spoke to them. They, in a similar vein, also did the things, that they had heard from their father.**

[Question] What did Jesus reveal to these Jews, that he knew and always spoke, and where did they come from?

[Question] Where did Jesus reveal, that their thoughts and speech came forth from?

- 2· Therefore, in answer, Jesus went on to say to them; Most truly I say to you, the Son cannot do a single thing of his own initiative, but only what he beholds the Father doing. For whatever things that One does, these things the Son also does in like manner. (John 5:19)**

[Question] What did Jesus state, about what things he could do, and who he imitated in all the things he did?

- 3· Do you not believe that I am in union with the Father, and the Father is in union with me? The things I say to you men, I do not speak of my own originality, but the Father, who remains in union with me, is doing his works. (John 14:10)**

[Question] Where did Jesus show, that all the things he spoke and taught, came forth from?

- 4· Because I have not spoken out of my own impulse, but the Father himself who sent me has given me a commandment as to what to tell, and what to speak. (John 12:49)**

[Question] Did Jesus ever speak out of his own impulse, for who told him what to speak?
