

John 8:42~ Jesus said to them; **If God were your Father, you would love me, for from God I came forth, and am here. Neither have I come of my own initiative at all, but that One sent me forth.**

1· So Jesus countered, that if they really had God as their Father, then they would love him, for Jesus came forth from the Father, and was standing here before them as his approved servant. Then Jesus showed them, that he had not come forth to them of his own initiative, but he was sent forth to them by God himself.

[Question] What did Jesus tell Jews who claimed to love Yehowah God as their spiritual Father?

[Question] Who then, did Jesus show, had send him forth?

2· For the Father himself has affection for you, because you have had affection for me, and have believed, that I came out as the Father's representative. (John 16:27)

[Question] Why would the Father love his anointed Christian sons, for what had they come to believe?

3· Everyone believing that Jesus is the Christ, has been born from God, and everyone who loves the one that caused to be born, loves him who has been born from that one. (1 John 5:1)

[Question] Who are the ones born from Yehowah God, and what do they all believe?

[Question] What have they all come to love, through their association with his son, Jesus Christ?

4· He, knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he came forth from God, and was going to God. (John 13:3)

[Question] What did Jesus know, about his future and his past, as he prepared to die in mankind's behalf?

5· For God loved the world so much, that he gave his only-begotten Son, in order, that everyone exercising faith in him, might not be destroyed, but have everlasting life. (John 3:16)

[Question] What shows the extraordinary love of Yehowah God for mankind?

[Question] What does Yehowah God want for all men to attain to?

- 6· Therefore, in answer, Jesus went on to say to them; Most truly I say to you, the Son cannot do a single thing of his **own initiative**, but only what he beholds the **Father** doing. For whatever things that **One** does, these things the Son also does, in like manner. (**John 5:19**)

[Question] What things did Jesus say that he could do, for who did he see doing these things, and then imitate?

- 7· But when the full limit of the time arrived, **God sent** forth his Son, who **came** to be out of a woman and who **came** to be under Law. (**Galatians 4:4**)

[Question] How did Yehowah God's son come to the earth, and under what circumstance?

- 8· Moreover, no man has ascended into heaven, but he that descended from heaven, the Son of man. (**John 3:13**)

[Question] What sole man, has ever ascended to heaven from the earth?

- 9· In answer Jesus **said** to them; This is the work of **God**, that you exercise faith in him, whom that **One sent** forth. (**John 6:29**)

[Question] What is the work of Yehowah God?

- 10· Because I **have come** down from heaven to do, not my will, but the will of him that **sent** me. (**John 6:38**)

[Question] Why did Jesus Christ come down from heaven to the earth?

- 11· Therefore Jesus cried out as he was teaching in the temple, and **said**; You both know me, and know where I **am** from. Also, I **have not come** of my **own initiative**, but he that **sent** me is real, and you do not know him. (**John 7:28**)

[Question] Who did Jesus tell visitors to the temple, that had sent him to preach?
