

John 8:46~ **Who of you convicts me of sin? If I speak truth, why is it you do not believe me?**

1· So Jesus asked them face to face, was there anyone among them who could convict him of sin. Of course there was no reason for their many complaints, they were just jealous of him, and his authority, and influence among the people. So when no one answered him he said; If then I speak the truth, then why is it that you do not believe me?

[Question] What did Jesus then challenge any one of them to do, if they could?

[Question] What did this show was the real reason for their many complaints?

[Question] How did Jesus respond to the silence, his challenge generated?

2· The one who did not know sin he made to be sin for us, that we might become God's righteousness by means of him. (2 Corinthians 5:21)

[Question] Who did Yehowah God send forth to become sin for mankind, and what can men become through him?

3· For we have as High Priest, not one who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who has been tested in all respects like ourselves, but without sin. (Hebrews 4:15)

[Question] What kind of a High Priest do anointed Christians have before them, pleading for them before Yehowah God in heaven, and how has he been tested?

4· For such a High Priest as this was suitable for us, loyal, guileless, undefiled, separated from the sinners, and become higher than the heavens. (Hebrews 7:26)

[Question] Why is Jesus suitable for anointed Christians as a High Priest, and to what position had he been raised up to?

5· He committed no sin, nor was deception found in his mouth. (1 Peter 2:22)

[Question] What did Jesus not commit, and what was not found within his mouth?

6· You know too that that one was made manifest to take

away our sins, and there is no sin in him. (1 John 3:5)

[Question] What was Jesus made manifest to do for mankind, and what was not within him?

- 7· Therefore Pilate said to him; Well, then, are you a king? Jesus answered; You yourself are saying that I am a king. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone that is on the side of the truth listens to my voice. (John 18:37)**

[Question] Why did Jesus come into the world of mankind, and who listens to Jesus?
