Jesus answered; I do not have a demon, but I honor my Father, and you dishonor me.

Footnote: Or, I am not demonized

1' So Jesus answered, that he did not have a demon, but he honored his heavenly Father, Yehowah God, and they were dishonoring him by saying he had a demon.

[Question] How did Jesus answer such opposers, for how did he feel and treat his heavenly Father, Yehowah God?

[Question] What were these men doing, by trying to say that the power of God he used, came forth from the demons?

2. A son, for his part, honors a father, and a servant, his grand master. So if I am a father, where is the honor to me? And if I am a grand master, where is the fear of me? Yehowah of armies has said to you, O priests, who are despising my name. And you have said; In what way have we despised your name? (Malachi 1:6)

[Question] As a grand master what is Yehowah God deserving of, and yet who was not giving this to Yehowah God as they should have?

3. You yourself have come to know my reproach and my shame and my humiliation. All those showing hostility to me are in front of you. (Psalms 69:19)

[Question] How did the Psalmist prophesy, about how the Messiah would feel, when among enemies among God's people?

4' We are fools because of Christ, but you are discreet in Christ. We are weak, but you are strong. You are in good repute, but we are in dishonor. (1 Corinthians 4:10)

[Question] How did the apostle Paul contrast the apostles' self-sacrificing course, to that of other pretenders to this God given office of oversight?
