John 8:50~ But I am not seeking glory for myself. There is One that is seeking, and judging.

1. Jesus then told then, that he was not seeking glory for himself, for there was only one deserving of this glory, and it was Yehowah God his heavenly Father. He was the one seeking and deserving of glory, and he would be the judge of all men.

**[Question]** What then, did Jesus show, that he was not seeking for himself, for who alone was deserving of this glory?

## 2. I do not accept glory from men. (John 5:41)

[Question] What did Jesus now accept from other men?

[Question] How different is this from many claiming to be his disciples today?

3. He that speaks of his own originality is seeking his own glory, but he that seeks the glory of him that sent him, this one is true, and there is no unrighteousness in him. (John 7:18)

[Question] What is the one, speaking from within his own heart, seeking for himself?

[Question] How does this differ for the one seeking God's glory?

4. It is unthinkable of you that you are acting in this manner, to put to death the righteous man with the wicked one, so that it has to occur with the righteous man, as it does with the wicked! It is unthinkable of you. Is the Judge of all the earth not going to do what is right? (Genesis 18:25)

[Question] How did Abraham recoil over the idea, that the righteous one and the wicked one, might share the same bad fate?

5. Judge me, O Yehowah, for I myself have walked in my own integrity, and in Yehowah I have trusted, that I may not wobble. (Psalms 26:1)

[Question] How did the Psalmist show, that he walked a fine course in life?

6 For Yehowah is our Judge, Yehowah is our Statute-giver, Yehowah is our King. He himself will save us. (Isaiah 33:22) [Question] Who is the ultimate judge of all mankind, and their savior?

7 Because he has set a day, in which he purposes to judge the inhabited earth in righteousness, by a man whom he has appointed, and he has furnished a guarantee to all men, in that he has resurrected him from the dead. (Acts of Apostles 17:31)

[Question] What day has Yehowah God set before all men, and what guarantee has he set that this day will come, regardless of whether wicked men want to see it come or not?

8. Never may that happen! How, otherwise, will God judge the world? (Romans 3:6)

**[Question]** What does Paul ask about Yehowah God venting his wrath over the failures of mankind?

 9 When he was being reviled, he did not go reviling in return. When he was suffering, he did not go threatening, but kept on committing himself to the one who judges righteously. (1 Peter 2:23)

[Question] How did Jesus go forth, when he himself was being mistreated?
