

John 8:51~ Most truly I say to you, if anyone observes my word, he will never see death at all.

- 1· So then, Jesus told them, that if anyone observes his word, by applying it in their lives and practicing it, then that one would never see death at all.

[Question] Who does Jesus show would never see death at all, and what must that one do?

- 2· Most truly I say to you, he that hears my word, and believes him that sent me, has everlasting life, and he does not come into judgment, but has passed over from death to life. (**John 5:24**)

[Question] Who has everlasting life remaining within him, and what has such a one passed over from, and to?

- 3· And everyone that is living, and exercises faith in me, will never die at all. Do you believe this? (**John 11:26**)

[Question] What will happen to everyone living, who puts faith in Jesus Christ, when he comes?

- 4· But when this which is corruptible puts on incorruption, and this which is mortal puts on immortality, then the saying will take place that is written: Death is swallowed up forever. (**1 Corinthians 15:54**)

[Question] When alone will death be swallowed up forever, and what is necessary before this can happen?

- 5· Happy and holy is anyone having part in the first resurrection, for over these the second death has no authority, but they will be priests of God and of the Christ, and will rule as kings with him for the thousand years. (**Revelation 20:6**)

[Question] How are all those having a share in the first resurrection described, and what no longer has any authority over them?

[Question] How then, will all such ones serve Yehowah God henceforth into eternity?
